Next Sunday: The Georgia Brass Band in Concert Right Here at 11AM!

I hope everyone in our church family will bring a friend next Sunday to church for a special service of sacred music presented by the acclaimed and talented Georgia Brass Band. The 11AM Worship hour will be our only worship hour next Sunday, so if you're a regular 8:30AM worshipper, plan to come at 11:00! Also, plan to stay for lunch immediately following. The lunch is provided by the church and is a fundraiser to support a very worthy cause: our church's upcoming mission trips to Alabama and El Salvador. Donations can be made at the door.

I know you want to know more about the Georgia Brass Band that's going to serenade and inspire us next Sunday! The GBB was conceived by co-founders Joe Johnson and Christopher Priest in the spring of 1999 over lunch at a Chinese restaurant. While lamenting the absence of a regular brass band in the area they simply decided to form one. Some notes were jotted down on a napkin and a string of phone calls to friends and colleagues ensued. The group met for the first time just several weeks later. The band performed its first concert in September of that year and has maintained a very busy schedule ever since.

The GBB has appeared on Atlanta radio and television and performed at schools, churches, concert halls, festivals, music camps, and colleges all around the southeastern United States. The band has had several concert performances broadcast on WABE-FM's Atlanta Music Scene program.

The GBB is a regular participant in the International Euphonium Institute held annually at Emory University in Atlanta. The band has also been featured at the US Army Ground Forces Band Tuba/Euphonium Conference at Fort McPherson, and as a headlining group at the Deep South Brass Band Festival in Pine Mountain, GA.

The GBB was a resident ensemble at the Dozier Centre for the Performing Arts in Kennesaw and served as a mentoring partner to the Georgia Youth Symphony Orchestra Brass Band, which also calls the Dozier Centre home.

Like the majority of brass bands all around the world, the GBB is a strictly volunteer organization. The musicians are some of the finest brass musicians in the state of Georgia, and most of them have had some level of professional musical training, but we might be surprised to learn that most of them have day jobs that are not related to performance. They are educators, business owners, attorneys, doctors, salespeople, composers, even a pipe-organ repairman!

So, come out next Sunday at 11AM for a very special treat and stay for lunch that supports our missions work! This truly will be a day of joy and celebration in the life of our church that we all will remember for many years to come!
